Students in the Museum's Greek Language and Culture classes will sing and dance and docents will be offering tours of the second floor exhibition *Aegean: Creation of an Archipelago* and the third floor exhibition *Reaching for the American Dream: The Greek Story in America*.

"There are so many unique and wonderful traditions that we want to share with families," said Dimitra Georgouses, Education and Public Programs Manager. "This is a perfect way for families to explore Greek culture and share in the warmth of the Greek spirit."

After the Christmas party, view the Greektown Christmas tree lighting celebration, hosted by the Greektown Special Services Area #16, on the corner of Halsted and Van Buren Streets at 5 p.m.
