General Info: Saturday language classes are for children in Preschool through high school. Children's classes are held on either Saturday morning or Saturday afternoons. Saturday morning classes are only for young children ages 3 – 7 and run from 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM. Saturday afternoon classes are for children in grades Pre-K through high school and run from 1:00 – 4:00 PM.

Please note: The pre-k and kindergarten afternoon classes will be very small. They are held to accommodate families who have children in other grade levels. If you are registering your 3-7 year olds and do not have older children registering, please consider the AM section.

New this year: The Jr. and Sr. Dance Groups (Grades 3 and up) will now meet with the dance teacher for 30 minutes during their allotted class time, 1:00 – 4:00 PM. You will receive a follow up email regarding dance class grouping as soon as registration numbers are established.
