General Info: Adult language classes are currently offered at a beginner level and intermediate level on Thursday afternoons. Intermediate level is offered from 5:30-6:45 PM. Beginner level is offered from 6:45-8:00 PM. All classes are held at the National Hellenic Museum at 333 S. Halsted St.

Basic/Beginner Classes: Basic Modern Greek (101) will be offered from September 2016 to December 2016. Our Beginner Modern Greek Class (102/103) will be offered from January 2017 to May 2017. For students interested in progressing from a basic class to our beginner sequence, they should register for a full year of class (September – May).

Intermediate Classes: Intermediate I (201) will be offered from September 2016 to December 2016. Our Intermediate II and III (202/203) sequence will be offered from January 2017 to May 2017. For students interested in progressing from Intermediate I through Intermediate III, should register for a full year of class (September – May).
